## A SINGLE $\$ 148$ MILLION POWERBALL JACKPOT TICKET SOLD IN LONG ISLAND

AUGUST 18, 2019 - The New York Lottery today announced that one first prize ticket was sold in New York for the August 17 Powerball drawing. The ticket is worth an annuitized $\$ 148$ million or a cash value of $\$ 105$ million.

The sole winning ticket was purchased at Merrick Gas and Repair in Merrick.

The winning numbers were $18,21,24,30$ and 60 and a Powerball of 20.

Powerball jackpots start at $\$ 40$ million and increase by a minimum of $\$ 10$ million per draw until the jackpot is won. Players select five numbers from 1 to 69; and one Powerball number from 1 to 26.

Powerball jackpot winners may choose to receive their prize as an annuity, paid in 30 graduated payments over 29 years, or a one-time lump sum payment. Both advertised prize options are prior to federal and state taxes.

A Lottery draw game prize of any amount may be claimed up to one year from the date of the drawing.
