Table Games

The proposed Gaming Facility is anticipated to have a total of 50 table games. The table games mix, which may change over time, is anticipated to include six baccarat tables, six craps tables, eight roulette tables, and twenty-two blackjack-type tables on the main gaming floor; plus an additional two baccarat tables, one craps table, two roulette tables, and three blackjack tables in the High Limit gaming room.

The baccarat tables offer fourteen seated positions each; the craps tables offer standing-room positions; the roulette tables offer seven seated positions each plus standing room; and the blackjack-style tables offer seven seated positions each.

Cage Layout

The Applicant anticipates the casino cage will be located in a centralized location on the proposed Gaming Facility's floor. The main cage is anticipated to have seven cashier windows for patron use, as well as two service windows for employee use.

The High Limit gaming area is also anticipated to have a dedicated cage for the convenience of its patrons. The High Limit Cage is anticipated to have two cashier windows, as well as one window for employee use.

Security camera coverage will be prevalent throughout the count room and entire cage area.

The OTB will offer another form of excitement and entertainment to guests of the facility.
