



Dear Members of the Resort Gaming Facility Location Board,

This letter is intended to express my support of the proposal to locate a casino in the City of Rensselaer submitted by Flaum Management Co. Inc, Global Gaming Solutions, Capital Region Off Track Betting, and Hard Rock International. Based on my discussions with representatives of the partnership I believe that a casino can have a positive impact on the residents and businesses in Rensselaer County by creating much needed jobs and economic vitality.

Currently, in excess of 30,000 residents of Rensselaer County are receiving some assistance through the various state and federal programs including Family Assistance, Safety Net, Public Assistance, Medicaid, HEAP, or Food Stamps. This is a staggering number that grew exponentially since the recession struck and continues to hold at record high levels today. I would also point out that our unemployment numbers for Rensselaer County have continued to drop indicating to me that many of our residents, while working, are underemployed or are making salaries significantly less than they were before the recession forcing their continued reliance on taxpayer funded assistance programs.

In my discussions with representatives of Flaum Management Co. Inc, Global Gaming Solutions, Capital Region Off Track Betting, and Hard Rock International I indicated that if they were successful in being chosen by New York State Gaming Commission my administration's focus would be to maximize the positive impacts of a casino and work to minimize or ameliorate any potential negatives. This is a tactic we take with any large scale economic development project.

My support of their proposal then is based on assurances received from Flaum Management Co. Inc, Global Gaming Solutions, Capital Region Off Track Betting, and Hard Rock International to address our concerns as well as to maximize the positive impacts of the casino for all County residents. They include:

RESOLUTION STATING SUPPORT FOR LOCATING A CASINO IN SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES IN RENSSELAER COUNTY

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body has long endeavored to protect and promote the economic vitality of Rensselaer County; and

WHEREAS, On November $5^{\rm th}$, in a referendum as part of the 2013 general election, state voters approved the development of seven commercial casinos, with Rensselaer County voters also voting in support of the commercial casino referendum; and

WHEREAS, Sighting for the commercial casinos approved by state voters is now underway across New York State; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body has received numerous calls of support for property located along the Hudson River waterfront in the City of Rensselaer known as DeLaet's Landing as a suitable site for a casino; and

whereas, This Legislative Body has also received calls from other entities, including the Capital District Off-Tracking Betting Corp., of which Rensselaer County is a member county, indicating other potential locations in Rensselaer County for a casino in different municipalities; and

WHEREAS, In recognition of the potential economic benefits, this Legislative Body is supportive of a commercial casino being located in the County, provided there is stated support from the host municipality; and

WHEREAS, One such host municipality, the City of Rensselaer, has previously declared support for location of a commercial casino on property known as DeLaet's Landing, and this Legislative Body recognizes the DeLaet's Landing property in Rensselaer has numerous positive attributes, including location directly across the Hudson River from downtown Albany, close proximity to the Rensselaer Train Station and busy state and interstate roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body further recognizes the positive attributes of other locations proposed as possible locations for commercial casinos, including proximity to other populated communities and major transportation roads and outlets, and while also noting the host municipalities have not yet considered issuing a declaration of support for such a venture; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy has historically served to protect those living, working, and conducting business in the City of Troy and is responsible for ensuring the fiscal stability and economic vitality of our community; and

WHEREAS, via a statewide referendum in November, 2013, state voters approved a plan to site seven casinos at locations throughout the state to bolster economic development efforts; and

WHEREAS, voters in the City of Troy and Rensselaer County approved the statewide referendum for the siting of the casinos; and

WHEREAS, in the months following approval of the casino siting plan in the 2013 elections, there have been numerous proposals in the Capital Region and Upstate New York for prospective casino locations; and


