The Sterling Forest Resort Project Site is located in the Town of Tuxedo, Orange County, New York. As shown in Figures VIII. C.1.a-1 through 5 below, this location brings with it numerous advantages. Of all of the projects proposed by the various applicants, Sterling Forest Resort is the closest to New York City at less than 35 miles, or less than 45 minutes' drive, away. This proximity ensures that the project will have the best access to the higher disposable income and population of that metropolitan area, as well as the approximately 50 million tourists visiting New York City annually. Sterling Forest Resort is also closest to large population centers in New Jersey and Connecticut and therefore is best positioned to attract interstate patrons, resulting in net economic growth within New York State. There are a multitude of Orange County entertainment, shopping and recreation facilities close to the Project Site, and the location in Tuxedo gives Sterling Forest Resort unparalleled access to regional and international markets.

The addresses by which the Project Site is currently known are 581 and 600 New York 17A, Tuxedo Park, Orange County, New York 10987. The Project Site is further described in that deed made to Faire Partners LLC from Sterling Forest LLC, as successor in interest by merger to Prospect Mountain Corp. and Sterling Forest Corporation, dated April 2, 2002 and recorded in the public records of Orange County, New York, on April 4, 2002, at book 5839 page 108, and consists of Orange County Tax Lots 37.2, 52.26, 36.32, 59.2 and 52.25 in Section 1 Block 1.
