The New York State Racing & Wagering Board has general jurisdiction over all horse racing activities and all pari-mutuel betting activities, both on-track and off-track, in the State of New York and over the corporations, associations and persons engaged therein. The Board also regulates the conduct of bingo games and games of chance by authorized non-profit organizations.

The Board consists of three members appointed for six-year terms by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate. Not more than two of the members shall belong to the same political party. The Governor designates one of the members as Chairman of the Board, who is Chief Executive Officer.

HIGHLIGHTS

In 1989, the State of New York hosted 1,681 days of racing (Thoroughbred and Harness) resulting in a combined handle of on and off track wagers totalling \$3,359,060,028. This was a decrease from the previous year.

As in previous years, the on-track handle continued to decline. The on-track handle of \$1,438,758,914 was 5% below the 1988 figures. The off-track handle was \$1,920,301,113

LEGAL ACTIVITIES

A number of significant court decisions resulting from Board determinations were forthcoming in 1989. Among them:

1. Mosher v. NYSRWB

The New York State Court of Appeals unanimously reversed the judgment of the Appellate Division, First Department, and reinstated the Board's determination which upheld a suspension based upon violation of the equine drug rules.

The court of Appeals held that proper application of the Trainer's Responsibility Rule requires separate consideration of whether there is substantial evidence of a positive drug test within the proscribed period followed by subsequent consideration of the trainer's responsibility for the violation.

2. Hedges v. Corbisiero

The United States District Court for the Southern District of New York ruled on an application for a preliminary injunction by a suspended harness driver. The Court (Goettel, J.) rejected the claim

that Board Rule 41119.9 (a) was unconstitutionally vague as applied to the improper signaling of wagering information by the driver. In addition, the Court rejected the claim, raised on the motion for an injunction, that the Board's hearing officer mechanism was constitutionally infirm.

3. DeBonis v. Corbisiero

The Appellate Division, First Department, unanimously confirmed the Board's revocation of a thoroughbred trainer's license based upon his attempt to commit fraud in connection with racing and breeding and by causing false information to be filed with the New York state Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund. The court held that it was proper, under the circumstances, for the Board to draw a negative inference from the Trainer's exercise of his right, under the Fifth Amendment of the United States Constitution, not to testify against himself at the administrative hearing.

4. Ferriola v. Corbisiero

The Appellate Division, First Department, unanimously rejected a thoroughbred trainer's challenge to a 120 day suspension of his license resulting from multiple post-race drug positives. The Court rejected arguments that petitioner had

demonstrated he was not responsible for the violations and found he had not been denied due process in the conduct of the hearing. The New York State Court of Appeals denied an application to review the case.

5. Kramer v. NYSRWB

The Appellate Division, Second Department, unanimously confirmed the Board's determination denying Mr. Kramer's 1987 application for a harness racing owner's license holding that the Board did not err in considering evidence of the activities underlying his previous indictment in order to assess character and fitness to participate. Additionally, the Court also confirmed the Board's denial of his 1988 license concluding that the weight to be accorded evidence of determination is supported by substantial evidence. A motion for leave to appeal to the Court of Appeals was denied as well.

6. Genesee Monroe Racing Association v. NYSRWB

The Supreme Court, Genesee County, dismissed the Article 78 petition commenced by Genesee holding that the Board clearly acted within its discretion and did not act arbitrarily or capriciously in making its determination to disallow Genesee's application to use capital improvement funds to lease simulcast equipment.

7. Trinity Episcopal Church of Gouveneur v. NYSRWB

The Supreme Court, County of St. Lawrence, determined that the Board properly exercised its judgment in authorizing the location of an OTB branch and did not act arbitrarily or capriciously. The Court held it would not substitute its judgment for that of the Board.

8. Crawford v. NYSRWB

The Supreme Court, Appellate Division, Third Department, confirmed the Board's eight (8) day suspension of Mr. Crawford's license based on interference. The Court rejected a challenge to the propriety of the Board's procedure of reducing an eight (8) day suspension to a five (5) days if the licensee does not appeal. It stated that such a procedure is essentially an offer to settle the final disposition of administrative charges without a hearing by mitigating the penalty to be imposed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Board enacted various amendments to its rules and regulations to ensure the continued safety and integrity of racing. Rules to prevent pre-tested horses from leaving the race grounds; to

allow more individuals to claim horses; to avoid multiple testing for equine infectious anemia within a short time frame; to clarify ownership transfers; and to provide for coupled entries when additional betting interests participate in thoroughbred racing were adopted by the Board during this year. Additionally, rules to allow individuals to readily obtain information from Board records, as well as requiring restrooms in off-track betting branches were promulgated for the benefit of the public.

LICENSING

In New York State, all participants in racing are required to obtain occupational licenses, which have been issued on an annual calendar year basis. In 1989, a total of 26,264 licenses were issued in Harness and Thoroughbred racing, there was no Quarterhorse racing during this year. A total of 12,229 licenses were issued for participants at the six Standard-bred tracks (Batavia, Buffalo, Monticello, Saratoga, Vernon Downs and Yonkers), as well as the annual Syracuse Mile Meet. In Thoroughbred racing, there were 11,815 licensees actively engaged at the New York Racing Association tracks (Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga) or at the Finger Lakes Race Track. Finger prints are required of license applicants. During the year there were a total of 12,153 Federal and State fingerprints processed; of this total, 3,431 were Federal fingerprints and 8,722 were State fingerprints.

In the Thoroughbred Division of Racing, there were 298 rulings issued for racing violations and rule infractions totaling \$23,475, as well as 787 days of suspensions.

In Harness Racing, there were 1,093 rulings issued for a total of \$40,200 in fines; there were also 5,306 days of suspensions.

The year 1989 saw the initiation of a 3-year licensing renewal program for certain occupational categories (Owners, Trainer, Drivers, Jockeys, etc.). This program was undertaken to facilitate the licensing process of those individuals who had satisfactorily been licensed the previous year and who, in many cases, seek licensing from a number of states, thereby reducing their licensing requirements. The introduction of the system has eased the administrative burdens of the Licensing Division, enabling the issuance of licenses on a more timely basis. Further research continues into the possible introduction of electronic technology advances to enhance future licensing processing.

The Investigations Unit handled 1,702 cases during the year in all areas of questionable racing activities: fixed racing attempts, equine and human drug usages, hidden ownerships, organized crime interests, insurance scams, among others.

New York State has the most comprehensive pre and post-race equine drug testing program in

the United States. The rules require that all horses racing at the tracks, in both Divisions of Racing, must undergo pre-race blood tests, and a number of them must be subjected to post-race blood and urine testing. This activity, so important in maintaining the integrity of racing, has resulted in the following statistics:

FINANCIAL AUDITS

Annual audits of all licensed harness tracks and the Finger Lakes thoroughbred track are performed by staff accountants.

Field audits of 1988 racing operations were completed for Batavia Downs, Buffalo Raceway, Monticello Raceway, Saratoga Raceway, Vernon Downs, Yonkers Raceway and Finger Lakes Race Track.

Special audits were also conducted at the above tracks in connection with their applications to withdraw monies from their capital improvement funds, except Yonkers Raceway which does not have a fund.

TRACK CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS

Selections 228-a and 319 of the Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law permit certain tracks to elect to withhold an additional 1% from regular and multiple pools from on-track betting to be used exclusively for capital

improvements. In addition, Section 527 requires the regional OTB corporations to retain a similar 1% from regular and multiple pools from on-track betting to be used exclusively for capital improvements. In addition, Section 527 requires the regional OTB corporations to retain a similar 1% from such off-track betting pools for tracks electing to withhold on-track, of which one half is paid to the tracks to be used exclusively for capital improvements; and the remaining one half is retained by each regional corporation for its own corporate purposes.

All tracks entitled to make the election have made it. The pari-mutuel takeout at such tracks is 18% instead of 17% from regular betting pools and 20% instead of 19% from multiple betting pools. The track association commission revenues derived from on-track betting and off-track betting for capital improvement additions are included, but not identified separately, in the accompanying charts as part of the total and association shares of commission. The capital improvement additions are indicated separately below as determined by Racing Board calculations.

SIMULCASTING OPERATIONS BY OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS AND RACE TRACKS DURING 1989

During 1989, the fifth full year of the simulcast experiment, all of the State's race tracks (with the exception of Vernon Downs and the Syracuse Mile) made a simulcast signal of its races available to the State's six off-track betting corporations. Five of the State's nine race tracks also were receiving tracks for simulcast signals. ■

The simulcasting of NYRA races was continued by Yonkers and Saratoga Raceways for the full year, by Finger Lakes for part of the year (88 days) as well as Aqueduct's simulcasting of the 24-day Saratoga meet. In addition, Vernon Downs began simulcasting races from both NYRA in the afternoon (139 days) and Yonkers Raceway in the evening (42 nights).

Simulcasting of in-state races by all off-track betting corporations continued on races from NYRA, Finger Lakes and Yonkers Raceway. New York City, Nassau and Catskill OTBs occasionally simulcast races from Monticello Raceway. Capital OTB continued to simulcast Saratoga Raceway races and simulcasting of Batavia Downs and Buffalo Raceway's harness races took place in the Capital and Western regions.

In 1989, the combined statewide on and off-track handle for all tracks fell by more than \$100 million, a 3.16% decline compared to 1988. On-track thoroughbred handle declined by almost 3.5% while on-track harness handle fell by over 9.5%. Total off-track handle declined by only 1.5% compared to 1988's levels. Total simulcast handle, however,

continued to rise. During 1989, 36.8% of the State's total betting handle was wagered at simulcast facilities compared to 33.5% in 1988.

A total of 177 simulcast facility licenses were issued in 1989, ten more than in 1988. Four were issued to race tracks (Aqueduct, Saratoga Raceway, Vernon and Finger Lakes), four to simulcast theaters (two in New York City, one each in Albany and Hauppauge) and 169 to off-track betting branches throughout the State. Collectively, these facilities conducted 706 simulcast operations. Sixteen were conducted under various court orders as a result of the Catskill OTB/Yonkers Raceway litigation.

The Racing Law establishes three distinct class classifications of simulcast facilities. Total simulcast handle during 1989 in each class were; Track to Track, \$162.3 million (up 9.5% compared to 1988); OTB Branches, \$1.06 billion (up 8.9%) and Simulcast Theaters, \$144.2 million (up 9.9%).

OTB simulcast handle on both NYRA and Yonkers races rose by approximately 8.8%, while Batavia/Buffalo's combined simulcast handle rose by 7.9%. Finger Lakes, which began its fourth full year of daily simulcasts to Western, Capital and Catskill, and on NYRA "dark days" to the other OTB regions, reported a 9.4% increase in simulcast handle in 1989. For the State's other tracks, simulcast handle declined: 3.5% at Monticello Raceway and 7.3% at Saratoga Raceway.

BINGO

Games conducted this year produced gross receipts of \$193,732,741 according to reports by the 2,724 authorized organizations.

Net profit to the participating organizations was \$50,376,714 and revenue to the municipalities was \$2,563,755. During the year, 17,926,072 persons played in 129,612 occasions.

The license fee for the conduct of an occasion of bingo is \$18.75, of which \$11.25 is remitted to the State and \$7.50 retained by the licensing municipality. Participating organizations are also required to pay an additional license fee of 3% of net profit which is retained wholly by the municipality for the enforcement of the applicable bingo laws and rules.

The State received \$1,446,152 bingo fees this year, including the license fees collected from qualified suppliers of equipment which amounted to \$23,130 and 50% of the fees charged to the licensed lessors of bingo premises. The supplier's fee, which is retained wholly by the State, is determined at \$25 plus a statutory schedule based upon the supplier's gross sales.

During the year, 59 new identification numbers were issued raising the total of such numbers issued since the inception of legalized bingo in 1958 to 7,811. The numbers were issued by the Board to organizations in 886 municipalities which have enacted local laws or ordinances permitting the conduct of bingo on a local option basis.

In addition, the Board issued identification numbers to 14 qualifying senior citizens organizations. There were no hotel bingo identification numbers issued during the year. The Board also must approve maximum rentals chargeable by licensed lessors and the expenditure of bingo funds by organizations as well as hearing appeals relating to municipal determinations.

The rules dealing with the conduct of "supercard" became effective during the year. It should be noted that the enabling legislation respecting this new type bingo games restricts its conduct to New York City.

GAMES OF CHANCE

Gross receipts of the 966 organizations conducting regular licensed games of chance in 1989 amounted to \$4,158,014. Net profits were \$3,018,608.

The Board is empowered to issue identification numbers to authorized organizations, to approve the expenditure of funds derived from the conduct of games of chance and license the suppliers of the equipment of such games. Since the program's inception, 3,545 games of chance identification numbers have been issued.

By the end of the year, 680 municipalities had passed local laws or ordinances permitting games of chance license periods on a local option basis.

Authorized organizations pay a fee of \$25 for each license period of which \$15 goes to the State and \$10 to the licensing municipality.

Licensed lessor organizations are assessed a fee of \$50 for each licensed period which is divided equally between the State and the licensing municipality.

The law also provides for an additional license fee, established by the Board at 5% of the organizations net profits, to be used by the municipalities for the enforcement of applicable laws and rules. This fee is retained wholly by the municipality.

The suppliers fee, payable to and retained by the State, has been established at \$25 plus 2% of the suppliers gross sales of rentals. The State received \$182,009 in games of chance fees this year including the license fees collected from qualified suppliers of equipment and supplies which amounted to \$125,369.

This year was the first full year regarding the licensing of organizations for the sale of bell jar and similar type tickets. Net profits earned by the 1070 organizations licensed to conduct such games amounted to \$9,323,511. The organizations are required to pay a \$25 fee for an annual license and an additional license fee of 2% of its net profits from such sales to be submitted with its quarterly reporting form. The annual license fees amounted to \$26,750 and the additional license fees to \$193,352.

TAKEOUT DISTRIBUTIONS FOR TRACK TO TRACK SIMULCASTS

Section 1007 of the racing law specifies that the takeout percentages from simulcast betting pools shall be the same as those applicable to the sending track (the track holding the race).

However, the pari-mutuel tax rates are different 2% of regular wagers, 2 and 1/2% of multiple wagers, and 7% of exotic and super exotic wagers, plus 10% of the breaks; or the pari-mutuel tax rates in effect at the receiving track (where the betting takes place), plus 10% of the breaks, if lower than these rates. The taxes listed above for on-track handles are presently the lower rates for all receiving tracks (Finger Lakes has no super exotic pools) except for NYRA simulcasts to its own tracks.

The receiving tracks are also obligated to pay 1% of the pools on harness races or 1/2% of the pools on thoroughbred races to the appropriate breeding fund. Of the sums retained by a receiving track, after payment of the pari-mutuel taxes and breeder fund shares, an amount as determined by agreement is payable to the sending track. The 1% allocations for capital improvements do not apply to track to track simulcasts.

Pursuant to Section 301.4, NYRA has elected to reduce the takeout on super-exotic bets to 25%, resulting in taxes and distributions at the same rates as for exotic bets.

*Pursuant to Board rules, for all tracks except NYRA, 2% of super-exotic takeouts are accumulated and must be returned to the bettors in guaranteed prizes or in the final pay-off of the meeting. Accordingly, the "effective" takeout is 34%, rather than the initial 36%.
