THE UPSTATE NY GAMING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT: PROJECTIONS OF NEW REVENUE FOR SCHOOL AID, PROPERTY TAX RELIEF, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AID AND JOB CREATION

EASTERN SOUTHERN TIER REGION

The Upstate New York Gaming Economic Development Act authorizes up to four gaming facilities in upstate New York – INCLUDING THE EASTERN SOUTHERN TIER REGION – and enhances the revenue distribution of existing upstate Indian Tribal gaming facilities.

Under the Act, regardless of location, all regions will receive allocation for additional school aid, property tax relief, and local government aid. The Eastern Southern Tier region's share is estimated at \$20 million and 10,000 jobs are projected to be generated upstate.

Job and construction spending estimates are based on the experience at gaming facilities in Pennsylvania and Maryland and use of the REMI model by Empire State Development.
