Amendment to clause 5.4.2 - Full Service Lottery System RFP December 10, 2008

5.4.2 Award Scale for Evaluation

The following rating system will be used by the Evaluation Committee to score each offeror's technical proposal. The consensus scoring method will be followed.

| Percent Allocation | Rating | Scoring Guidelines |
|-----------------------|-------------|---|
| 91-100 | Outstanding | The offeror exceeds the criteria. The services described indicate that the offeror will provide very high quality services and is pro-active and innovative. |
| 81-90 | Very Good | The offeror meets but does not exceed the criteria. The services described indicate that the offeror will meet the program needs. The offeror demonstrates some innovative features. |
| 71-80 | Good | The offeror meets the criteria, but does not demonstrate any innovative features. |
| 60-70 | Fair | The offeror's response is minimal or the response is very general and the Committee has identified some limitations. |
| 59 or less | Poor | The offeror does not respond to the requirement in a clear manner and the Committee has concerns with the offeror's approach or capabilities. |

Minimum Qualifying Score: The achievement of a minimum qualifying technical score of at least sixty percent (60%) of available points on each of the technical categories defined in RFP Section 5.4.1 is required for the vendor to advance to the price evaluation. Any vendor not meeting this threshold may be removed from further consideration.
