The cage layout is similar to the one at Rivers Casino in Des Plaines, IL. There will be 6-8 windows for guests to approach and 1 ADA window. For the Team members of the Cage, there are two independent areas. One is from the casino floor, where a Team Member will bring change from the casino floor into the Employee Bank. From there money is transferred across a counter to the Cage attendant, who logs the transaction, then turns it over to the Main Bank attendant where it is again counted and transferred through a small opening to the Soft Count room. Once the transfer occurs into the Soft Count room, the second independent Team Member has access to that room through an electronic 'man trap' that cannot be accessed without security clearance.

7. Description of size, layout, and location of count room.

Money from the Soft Count room is logged and stored. Removal is only done by guards with special clearance. As an additional measure of security, the perimeter walls and ceilings will include tightly spaced expanded metal lathe. The room is approximately 1,000 square feet and is located off of the back of house corridor where money will be escorted to an armored vehicle.

8. Layout of players-club areas, include number of stations, location, etc.

The Player's Club will also be similar to Rivers Casino in Des Plaines, IL. Located near the main entry, it will include a walk-up counter for guests where they will be greeted by a Team Member. The Team Member has access to a back room that will include an office and storage space for promotional events.
