Traditions Resort & Casino is adjacent to a 200 acre natural preserve that has over 6 miles of paved walking trails. There is a private entrance into the trails from Traditions' property that is used exclusively for guests and neighboring townhouse residents.

The Traditions team is currently working out the logistics for a zip line course to be installed in the wooded lot above the golf course. Spanning over 150 acres, the landscape offers a variety of elevation changes that would make it the perfect home for amenity zip line course.

The Traditions property was used as a recreation area for IBM Employees. When the resort was owned/operated by IBM, it was not unusual to see horseshoe pits, volleyball courts, croquet, bocce, tennis and camp fires. Traditions Resort & Casino will restore all of these amenities and provide access to all guests.

Traditions Resort & Casino will also be utilized as a venue for special events. There is great interest from the community to host events such as mud runs, 5k and half marathons onsite due to the expansive land and terrain features. These events typically draw thousands of attendees and will result in great exposure to the resort and casino.
