Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 7- Jockey of the second place finisher #2 Vagabond (Jose Ortiz) claimed foul against first place finisher #6 Puca (Junior Alvarado) for alleged interference at the top of the stretch. #6 Puca shifts over a path while clear in conjunction with the #2 Vagabond making a move for a tight spot. After reviewing the race video and speaking to all the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted and the race is official as is. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 2- #11 Kentucky Road trained by Michael Maker and ridden by Joel Rosario was pulled up and taken off on the horse ambulance. Claim was voided.

Incident Race 6- Horse Majestic Mac kicked rider Eric Cancel in the chest in the paddock prior to the race. Horse was scratched.

For having waived your right of appeal 10 days are hereby stayed for 1 year from the date of this ruling pending no further infractions with health certificates.

Mike Maker- Trainer- You are hereby fined \$3000.00 which is reduced to 1500.00 for having waived your right of appeal, this for running horses Great Lou in the Claiming Crown Express Stakes and Creaky Cricket in the Claiming Crown Canterbury Stakes at Gulfstream Park on December 3, 2016 without prior approval of the NYRA Stewards as per New York State Gaming Commission rule 4038.4.
