Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 1- Jockey of the fifth place finisher #4 Speightman (Samuel Camacho, Jr.) claims foul against fourth place finisher #5 Kitai (Austin Solis) for alleged interference leaving the gate. #5 Kitai breaks in sharply and #4 Speightman has to steady taking away her momentum. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #5 is disqualified from fourth place and placed fifth. Decision was unanimous. New order of finish: 6, 3, 1, 4, 5, 2.

No Incidents Occurred

Jockey Meeting Race 1 and 2- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with rider Austin Solis to review the start and disqualification in race 1 and the use of the crop in race 2. After review the Stewards issued no sanctions for race 1 but the safety of the riders and the other horses was stressed. For race 2, the Stewards issued a warning for the misuse of the crop as his use was not going to improve the horses position.

Jockey Movie Review Race 4- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with rider John Bisono to review the stretch run of the race. After review the Stewards issued a warning to John Bisono for taking his horse to the outside without being clear, in addition the Stewards stressed the safety of other riders and horses.

Incident Race 1- Horse Our Karma jumped over the outer rail after unseating his rider in the post parade. There were no reported injuries.

Jockey Movie Review Race 3- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with riders Irad Ortiz, Jr. and Eric Cancel to review the top of the stretch run of the race where at the 1/4 pole their two horses come together. After review the Stewards issued no sanctions but discussed the importance of spacing between horses turning into the stretch as the safety of the horses and riders is paramount. Mr. Ortiz was also instructed to keep a straight course as he drifted in the stretch although he was clear.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 3- Jockey of the second place finisher #6 Beautyinthepulpit (John Bisono) claims foul against first place finisher #5 Pretension (Cornelio Velasquez) for alleged interference leaving the gate. In the vicinity of the 1/8 pole, #5 Pretension floats out slightly before going on to win. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 4- Inquiry into the start, #7 Super Allison (Gabriel Saez) broke slowly after the gates opened. After reviewing the race video in the judgement of the Stewards #7 Super Allison caused her own problem and the race is official as is. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Trainer Objection Race 6- Trainer of the third place finisher #3 Eden Ridge (Kendrick Carmouche) claims foul against second place finisher #7 Core Portfolio (Aaron Gryder) for alleged interference in the vicinity of the 1/4 pole. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.
