Stewards Inquiry Race 1- Inquiry into the stretch run, #2 Cuantos (Junior Alvarado) fell in the vicinity of the 1/8 pole and suffered a fatal injury. #5 Blame Jim (Manuel Franco) rider was unseated after colliding with #2 Cuantos. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards the race is official as is. Decision was unanimous.

Equine Death Race 1- #2 Cuantos trained by Mark Hennig and ridden by Junior Alvarado fell in the vicinity of the 1/8 pole and was humanely euthanized on track.

Incident Race 1- #5 Blame Jim trained by Todd Pletcher and ridden by Manuel Franco unseated the rider when colliding with fallen horse #2 Cuantos. Jockey was taken off on human ambulance.

Ruling- Junior Alvarado- Jockey- You are hereby suspended 5 NYRA racings days which is reduced to 3 NYRA racing days for having waived your right of appeal. This for careless riding during the running of the 9th race at Aqueduct Racetrack on April 9, 2016.

Stewards Inquiry Race 2- Inquiry into the first stretch run, the left rein broke on #5 Don't Point (Dylan Davis) and the rider was unseated. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards the race is official as is. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 6- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #8 Nexrad (Manuel Franco) claimed foul against first place finisher #1 Money Multiplier (Jose Ortiz) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 1/8 pole #1 Money Multiplier drifts out and makes contact with #8 Nexrad. After reviewing the race video and speaking to all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Trainer Objection Race 9- Trainer of the fifth place finisher #10 Foggy Mountain Cat (Irada Ortiz, Jr.) claims foul against the fourth place finisher #7 Par (Eric Cancel) for alleged interference in the first turn. In the vicinity of the 7/8 pole #4 Magical Mirror (Katie Davis) bore out forcing #7 Par into #10 Foggy Mountain Cat. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 2- #5 Don't Point trained by Gary Contessa and ridden by Dylan Davis passing in the stretch for the first time had the left rein break causing the rider to be unseated.

Jockey Movie Review Race 6- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with rider Jose Ortiz to review him coming out while riding #1 Money Multiplier in the stretch and making contact with #8 Nexrad. After review the Stewards issued a \$1,000 fine for careless riding and stressed the safety of both the horses and riders.

Jockey Movie Review Race 9- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with riders Samuel Camacho, Jr., Katie Davis and Eric Cancel to review #5 Scarselletta ridden by Samuel Camacho, Jr. coming out after the start of the race onto #4 Magical Mirror ridden by Katie Davis and in the first turn #4 Magical Mirror comes out into #7 Par ridden by Eric Cancel who then makes contact with #10 Foggy Mountain. After review the Stewards issued a warning to Samuel Camacho, Jr. and no other sanctions were given.
