Stewards Inquiry and Trainer Objection Race 8- Inquiry in the vicinity of the 5/16 pole, #6 Little Chiseler (Dylan Davis) stumbled losing her rider. #6 Little Chiseler appears to clip heels with #2 Offlee Good (Talbert Howell) around the far turn as that horse is taken off the rail. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was necessary. Decision was unanimous.

In addition, the trainer of the third place finisher #10 Party Mint Star (Addiel Ayala) claimed foul against the second place finisher #5 Sapporo (Kendrick Carmouche) for alleged interference at the top of the stretch. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the race was made official as is. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 8- #6 Little Chiseler trained by Gary Sciacca and ridden by Dylan Davis appeared to clip heels and unseated her rider.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 9- Jockey of the second place finisher #11 Bootlegger (Junior Alvarado) claimed foul against the first place finisher #1 He's Cheeky (Irad Ortiz, Jr.) for alleged interference in the stretch. Inside the 1/16 pole #1 He's Cheeky reacts to his riders right hand crop and drifts in along with #11 Bootlegger who is racing inside of him. #1 He's Cheeky and #11 Bootlegger brush as both straighten out nearing the finish. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards this incident did not alter the finish of the race and the race is official as is. Decision was unanimous.

This is a violation of 9 NYCRR 4035.9 (c)(1) as to where you strike a horse and as the goggles are not approved equipment to strike a horse during the running of a race. You also have been previous warned not to use the goggles to strike a horse during the running of a race by the NYRA Board of Stewards.

Stewards Inquiry Race 5- Inquiry in the vicinity of the 3/16 pole, #4 Flatterfly (Junior Alvarado) suffered a fatal musculoskeletal injury. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards no further action was necessary. Decision was unanimous.

Equine Death Race 5- #4 Flatterfly trained by Gary Contessa and ridden by Junior Alvarado fell after suffering a musculoskeletal injury in the vicinity of the 3/16 pole and was euthanized on track.
