Stewards Inquiry Race 6- Inquiry into the start, #5 On a Snowy Evening (Fernando Jara) stumbles leaving the gate and unseats his rider. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards no other horses were involved and no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 6- #5 On a Snowy Evening trained by Abigail Adsit and ridden by Fernando Jara stumbled coming out of the gate and unseated her rider.

Stewards Inquiry, Trainer Objection and Jockey Objection Race 1- Trainer and Jockey of the third place finisher #6 Queen Katherine (Ruben Silvera) claim foul against the first place finisher #3 Sweetneida (Angel Cruz) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 3/16 pole #3 Sweetneida drifts in slightly while passing #6 Queen Katherine inside. #6 Queen Katherine steadies and shifts out and continues to drift out through the stretch. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 2- Jockey of the third place finisher #2 Prima Storm (Joel Rosario) claim foul against the first place finisher #8 Burdines (Irada Ortiz, Jr.) for alleged interference in the stretch. #8 Burdines drifts out in the stretch causing the #2 Prima Storm to take hold and alter course as he is advancing. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #8 Burdines is disqualified from first and placed third. New order of finish is 1, 2, 8, 7, 6, 5. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 9- Jockey of the third place finisher #9 Harpoon (Paco Lopez) claim foul against the second place finisher #5 Vinceremos (Javier Castellano) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 1/16 pole #5 Vinceremos shifts out several paths while being struck with a left handed crop causing the #9 Harpoon to check sharply. #5 Vinceremos then bumps #1 Speeding Comet (Manuel Franco) on the far outside. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #5 Vinceremos is disqualified from second and placed third. New order of finish is 1, 9, 5, 2, 4, 7, 11, 3, 8, 10. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 1- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #2 Welcome Speech (Rajiv Maragh) claims foul against the first place finisher #6 Pure of Spirit (Irad Ortiz, Jr.) for alleged interference in the stretch. #6 Pure of Spirit drifts out slightly mid stretch as #2 Welcome Speech also takes a step in causing him to take a brief hold. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 7- #7 Spotless (Eduardo Ulloa) breaks sharply and takes a step out filling a spot where #8 Payment Terms (Luis Saez) leaves breaking slowly making contact with #9 Euros to Dollars (John Velazquez) who has pressure from #11 Elusive New Yorker (Rajiv Maragh) and #10 Manofire (Joel Rosario) outside of him. #7 Spotless stumbles after making contact and unseated her rider. Jockey of the third place finisher #10 Manofire (Joel Rosario) claims foul against the first place finisher #8 Payment Terms (Luis Saez) for alleged interference around the 3/16 pole. #8 Payment Terms passes #10 Manofire on the outside who is pushed out slightly by the #5 Wind Warning (Cornelio Velasquez). After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 7- #7 Spotless trained by Gregory DiPrima and ridden by Eduardo Ulloa was in tight quarters coming out of the gate and lost his footing and unseated his rider.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 6- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #4 Strike Tone (Irad Ortiz, Jr.) claims foul against the third place finisher #8 Day of Fury (Angel Cruz) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 1/8 pole #8 Day of Fury drifts out crossing in front of #4 Strike Tone. #4 Strike Tone alters course to the inside as #8 Day of Fury was clear at the time. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Ruling- Irad Ortiz, Jr.- Jockey- You are hereby suspended 5 calendar days for careless riding during the running of the 1st race at Belmont Park on June 26, 2015. Having appealed, a stay of the license suspension or revocation is hereby granted; however, Commission counsel may make a motion for the stay to be terminated in the event that the appeal hearing is not completed within 90 days of this ruling. If the stay is terminated because of an unreasonable delay in the completion of the hearing, then the license suspension or revocation would begin and run until the appeal hearing is completed. The licensee is also hereby granted a separate stay that will begin only after the appeal hearing is completed. This second stay will terminate when the Commission issues its final agency action (e.g., finding and order).
