Rulings- Uriah A. St. Lewis- Owner-Trainer- Having received a report from the New York Drug Testing and Research Program for the finding of the drug "Flunixin" in the bodily fluid samples of horse "Dan's Gold" who finished 2nd in the 5th race at Aqueduct Racetrack on March 21, 2015. Trainer Uriah St Lewis is hereby suspended 15 days and fined \$1000.00. Horse Dan's Gold is hereby disqualified from any share of the purse money and unplaced in the order of finish. For having waived your right of appeal 8 days are stayed pending no horse trained by you has a equine positive in a pari-mutuel jurisdiction on or before October 18, 2015.

Ordered that during your period of suspension , you shall not directly or indirectly participate in New York State Pari-mutuel horse racing. You are denied the privileges and use of the grounds for all racetracks, you are forbidden to participate in any share of the purses or other payments. Every horse is denied the privileges of the grounds and shall not participate in pari-mutuel racing in New York State, that (a) is owned or trained by you, or by individuals who serve as your agent or employee during your suspension; or (b) for which you during your suspension are directly or indirectly with training, including any arrangements to care for, train, enter, race, invoice, collect fees or other payments, manage funds, employ or insure workers, provide advise or other information or otherwise assist with any aspect of the training of such horse.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 5- Rider of the second place finisher #8 Night Officer (Manuel Franco) claims foul against the first place finisher #4 Street Shark (Pablo Fragoso) for alleged interference in the stretch. Inside the 1/16 pole #4 Street Shark drifts out under a left handed crop and makes contact with #8 Night Officer approaching the wire while altering his stride. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the final placement of the race and #4 Street Shark is disqualified from first place and placed second. New order of finish 8, 4, 7, 6, 5, 1. Unanimous decision.

Incident Race 6- #6 Pinball trained by David Jacobson and ridden by Angel Cruz was pulled up at the 1/8 pole and taken off the track on the horse ambulance.

Incident Race 7- #4 Surfspun trained by Jeremiah Englehart and ridden by Rajiv Maragh suffered heat exhaustion in paddock following the running of the 7th race.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 9- Rider of the third place finisher #10 Tom's Vision (Israel Rodriguez) claims foul against the second place finisher #3 My Friend Keith (Rajiv Maragh) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 1/16 pole #10 Tom's Vision has to check sharply as #3 My Friend Keith drifts out under a left handed crop. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the final placement of the race and #3 My Friend Keith is disqualified from second place and placed third. New order of finish 1, 10, 3, 5, 9, 4, 12, 11, 13, 7, 6. Unanimous decision.

Incident Race 9- #6 Wild Prado trained by Jose Polanco and ridden by Eduardo Ulloa never raced in contention and was eased.

Rulings- Robby J. Albarado- Jockey- You are hereby suspended 3 NYRA racing days for careless riding during the running of the 7th race at Belmont Park on June 6, 2015. Having appealed, a stay of the license suspension or revocation is hereby granted; however, Commission counsel may make a motion for the stay to be terminated in the event that the appeal hearing is not completed within 90 days of this ruling. If the stay is terminated because of an unreasonable delay in the completion of the hearing, then the license suspension or revocation would begin and run until the appeal hearing is completed. The licensee is also hereby granted a separate stay that will begin only after the appeal hearing is completed. This second stay will terminate when the Commission issues its final agency action (e.g., finding and order).

Martin A. Pedroza- Jockey- You are hereby suspended 3 NYRA racing days, June 20, 2015, June 21, 2015 and June 24, 2015, this for careless riding during the running of the 9th race at Belmont Racetrack on June 6, 2015. Having waived your right of appeal permission to ride in a designated race the Ohio Derby at Thistledown on June 20, 2015 is permitted. If so suspension extended 1 NYRA racing day, June 25, 2015.
