## Re: Notice of Violation 18-RWC-04

Dear [REDACTED],

The New York State Gaming Commission, Division of Gaming has investigated an incident that occurred on February 26, 2018 at Resorts World Catskill during which an individual identified by Resorts World Catskills as underage male [REDACTED] was allowed access to the gaming floor.

Commission Commercial Gaming Supervising Inspector [REDACTED] and Senior Gaming Inspector [REDACTED] reviewed the Resorts World Catskill Surveillance Report [REDACTED] [REDACTED] as well as relevant video evidence of the incident.

Chief Compliance Officer [REDACTED] advised the New York State Gaming Commission (NYSGC) of an underage patron who was escorted off the gaming floor around 12:15 PM. The NYSGC conducted a review of the incident in question and observed the following actions take place.
11:17AM	[REDACTED]	The underage male, later identified as [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] with date of birth [REDACTED]), gained access to the Resorts World Catskills Gaming Floor unchallenged for identification by Security Officer [REDACTED].

11:20 AM	[REDACTED]	[REDACTED] gamed at Slot Machine [REDACTED] for a total of six spins.

Failure to appeal within 30 days will be considered a waiver of any available appeal, and any requests to appeal received after the 30 days will be rejected as untimely.
