## Notice of Violation 22-Rivers-02 Sent Via Electronic Mail ( [REDACTED] )

The New York State Gaming Commission, Division of Gaming (NYSGC) has reviewed an incident that occurred on May 15, 2022, at Rivers Casino and Resort, operated by Capital Region Gaming, LLC (Rivers), during which an underage person was allowed access to the casino gaming floor.

On 05/15/22 at approximately 1:00am, underage patron (UAP) [REDACTED] (date of birth [REDACTED]) enters Rivers with patron [REDACTED] and her associates. Patron [REDACTED] facilitated giving the IDs of all patrons in her group to the Rivers Security Officers at the podiums. Patron [REDACTED] hands two (2) vertical IDs to the Officers. One is scanned by Security Officer [REDACTED] for UAP [REDACTED]. UAP [REDACTED] is permitted access to the gaming floor. UAP [REDACTED] exits Rivers and meets with her associate who was denied access to the gaming floor for being underage. UAP [REDACTED] and her associates then begin walking towards the Elevator Entrance. UAP [REDACTED] and her associates are interviewed at the Elevator Entrance by Security Officer [REDACTED], Security Manager [REDACTED], and Security Supervisor [REDACTED]. UAP [REDACTED] gains access to the gaming floor without presenting any ID. UAP [REDACTED] walked the gaming floor with her associates. UAP [REDACTED] met with patron [REDACTED] and the remainder of the group at Flipt. The group receives a phone call and walks through the middle of the gaming floor and exit through the elevator entrance. UAP [REDACTED] was on the gaming floor for a total of thirteen (13) minutes and five (5) seconds. Attached you will also find the underage ID used by UAP [REDACTED]

If you wish to contest the violations set forth in this letter, you may request a hearing pursuant to Article 3 of the State Administrative Procedure Act and Article 13 of the Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law. Please submit a request for a hearing to Kristen Buckley, Acting Secretary to the Commission, New York State Gaming Commission, One Broadway Center, Schenectady, New York 12305 within 30 days of receipt of this letter. Failure to request a hearing within 30 days of the date of this Notice shall be considered a waiver of any available hearing, and any requests for a hearing received after the 30 days will be rejected as untimely.
