**C. Statute, Regulation or Internal Control Violated:**

New York State Gaming Commission Rules and Regulations

§ 5117.1. Underage gaming violations.

- (a) No video lottery gaming agent, representative, licensed employee or contractor thereof, shall allow, permit or suffer any person under the age of 18 years (underage person) to:
  - (3) be present on the gaming floor without the escort of a licensed video lottery facility employee and for longer than necessary to reach a destination that is not on the gaming floor.
- (c) Each violation of any of the provisions of subdivision (a) of this section as to a single underage person shall be considered a separate and distinct violation.
- (2) The commission shall penalize a licensee found to have violated paragraph (3) of subdivision (a) of this section as follows: (i) for a first violation, a fine of \$1,000;

**D. Summary of Violations:**

On July 22, 2021 at approximately 2:35 PM, two female patrons with one of them pushing an infant occupied stroller, entered through the South Entrance (██████████) and onto the gaming floor. Security Officer ██████████ who was posted there, failed to intercept the stroller as he was distracted by Security Manager ██████████. Manager ██████████ was walking by and had a brief exchange with him right when the stroller rolled pass between them. Surveillance video showed the stroller was on the gaming floor for approximately 7 minutes before it was realized and escorted off the floor by Security Officer ██████████. No underage play was observed throughout the incident.

Security should have prevented the infant in stroller from accessing the gaming floor or provided escort to prevent underage loitering or gaming. Security Officer ██████████ and Security Manager ██████████ both missed the opportunity to prevent the violation. It is recommended for the facility to ensure that all staff understands their duties and always remain vigilant.

Accordingly, the Division of Gaming hereby levies a fine of \$1,000 to Saratoga Casino Hotel. Please respond and remit the fine to the New York State Gaming Commission on or before 08/30/2021. ██████████
