The New York State Gaming Commission Division of Gaming has reviewed an incident that occurred on December 29, 2017 at del Lago Resort and Casino during which an underage person was allowed access to the gaming floor and allowed to wager.

On December 29, 2017 at 17:55 hours, an underage patron later identified as [REDACTED] was observed entering the casino floor via the hotel entrance. [REDACTED] proceeded past Security Officer [REDACTED]. Based on review of surveillance video, Officer [REDACTED] did not attempt to identify underage [REDACTED]
