### Aid to Municipalities with Video Lottery Gaming Facilities Program

Beginning in FY 07/08, in accordance with Section 54-L of the State Finance Law, cities, counties, towns, or villages that host a video lottery gaming facility will receive annual aid payments from the Office of the State Comptroller. State aid payments made to an eligible municipality are used to defray local costs associated with a video lottery gaming facility, to reduce real property taxes, or to increase support for public schools. In Fiscal Year 2024-2025 host municipalities of the Resorts World Hudson Valley facility were scheduled to receive the following aid payments:
